

## Step 1: Take a Picture



- When you come across something when you're out and about that is a pain or a pleasure, take a shot of it
- Jot down a quick note on how you feel about it (Skip this step and go right to Step 2 if you have a smart phone)
- Here's a list of examples to get you started:
  1. *Construction on the sidewalk, path or road*
  2. *A nice path you use for a shortcut*
  3. *Narrow sidewalks (patios or porches blocking the way)*
  4. *An area you find particularly beautiful (view or otherwise)*
  5. *Potholes or major cracks in the sidewalk, road, or path*
  6. *Particularly inconvenient or dangerous intersections*
  7. *Good or bad accessible parking*
  8. *Well and poorly lit portions of the city*
  9. *Bump or little hills that make it unnecessarily difficult*
  10. *Good or bad ramps*
  11. *Good or bad business and public washrooms*
  12. *Good or bad elevators*

## Step 2: Post and Share



- Upload your picture to your computer (if using a smart phone skip this step)



- Sign up for an account (if you don't have one)
- Search for 'Mapability' and click on the one with the green M
- Click the box with 'Write something on this page' and fill in your description and add 'AccessHFX' to the end
- Click on the camera icon, find where you saved your picture, and upload it
- Click the location icon and enter the approximate location of the issue (if it's a common place, type the name and select the right spot). **And Post**



- Sign up for an account (if you don't have one)
- Click on the box to compose a tweet
- Enter a brief description (140 characters max) leaving enough room to add '#AccessHFX' and '@Mapabilityapp' to the end
- Click on the camera icon, find the location where you saved your picture, and upload it
- Add a brief description of the location (e.g. Robie and Quinpool intersection). **And Post**
